STEP 4: Proof of Full-Time Enrollment Status

You may validate enrollment by submitting any one of the following:

- your academic transcript, current class schedule, enrollment verification, letter from your school's registrar or sponsoring professor

We do **NOT** accept:

- student ids, acceptance letters, tuition/housing/activity receipts

The document **must** include:

- your name, your school's name, date of the semester, either the number of credit hours or clearly state full-time status
